




GOAL POST LEG DESIGN



ENVIRONMENTAL

Imperial Office Furniture are accredited to both ISO 14001 and the FSC® (Forest Stewardship Council®), and as such has a commitment both to manage its impact on the climate generally, and to source all timber, including MFC, from managed sustainable forests which comply with this internationally recognised forestry standard and where harvesting is controlled as a part of a future sustainability plan.

Being largely manufactured from waste wood, MFC contributes to saving deforestation. Any offcuts created in the production process are returned to stock for use and arrangements are in place onsite for the recycling of large wood wastes, grinded offcuts and dust created by our processes, as well as paper, cardboard, boarding and pallet packaging received with deliveries, in order to minimise our environmental impact. These measures are externally assessed on an annual basis as a part of our ISO 14001 accreditation to ensure ongoing and continuous development and improvement.

PRODUCT SPECIFICATION

All of the Imperial desking, table and storage ranges comprise multiple width, height and shape options and are combined with extensive leg and accessory options. All items manufactured by Imperial carry a 5 year guarantee.

All timber products are manufactured from MFC (Melamine Faced Chipboard), which is itself manufactured from waste wood that would otherwise have been disposed of and the MFC sourced by Imperial consists of 20% hackchips, 20% sawdust and 40% of other wood recycled materials. It is a practical and low maintenance material for the office environment; scratch, crack, impact and abrasion resistant, colour fast under artificial light and recyclable.

MAINTENANCE

Although resistant to household cleaning products and chemicals, MFC is designed by finish to be low maintenance and requires nothing more than a dust down and wipe clean with warm soapy water. No waxing, de-waxing, polishing or other surface treatment is required.

Regular monthly inspections for any loose fixings, such as screws, nuts, bolts and handles, or for any defects are recommended, especially in moving components such as hinges, runners, castors, locks and doors.
